Traditionally, the Advent wreath symbolizes the passage of the four weeks of Advent. During the season of Advent one candle on the wreath is lit each Sunday until all of the candles, including the fifth candle, are lit on Christmas Day. The three purple candles represent Hope, Preparation for Christ's Birth and Love. The pink candle represents Joy and the white candle, lit on Christmas day is the Christ candle.
