School Coats and all uniform items are now available to purchase from school.

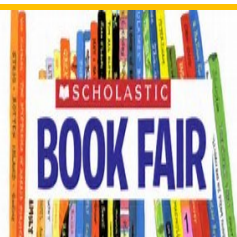
Christmas at St Aloysius
