Year 6: Topic - Disasters

English

This term year 6 will be reading and responding to 'Kensuke's Kingdom' by Michael Morpugo.

Children will be learning to write a range of text types including:

- An alternative ending to a story.

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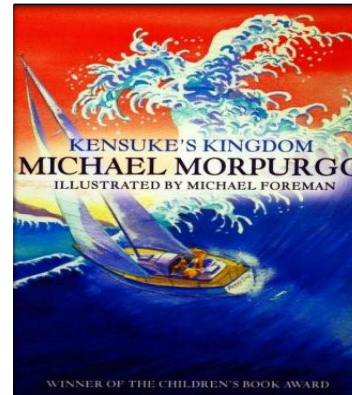
Advent to Christmas

Mathematics

Fractions, Ratio and Proportion, Shape

This half term children will be learning:

- **To calculate with fractions**
- express a relationship between a whole and equal parts of a whole.
- Identify 3D shapes and discuss their properties.
- Measure and calculate angles.
- Work out ratios and proportions and solve real life problems involving these.

Science

- Children will research a range of natural disasters and how they occur.
- Children will plan and conduct scientific experiments linked to natural disasters.

Computing

- CLC— movie making program.
- Children will use Word to publish their alternative endings. Children will use the internet to research.

Foundation Subjects

History, Geography, Art, DT, Music and PE

History: children will learn about Pompeii and the life in Rome at the time.

Geography: children will be using maps to study locations where natural disasters are most likely to occur.

DT: children will be making their own model volcanoes.

Art: children will paint their own images of natural disasters.
