English

- Diary entries.

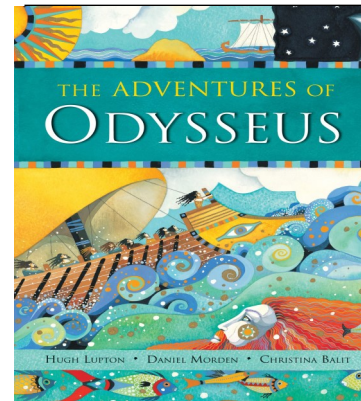
RE

Children will learn about:

- know what happened at the Last Supper;

- know that when we receive Holy Communion we truly receive the Risen Jesus.

Children will also learn about Judaism.



Foundation Subjects

History, Geography, Art, DT, Music and PE

History: children will learn about Ancient Greece and what has derived from the Greek culture.

Geography: children will be using maps to locate major cities and events in Ancient Greece.

DT: children will be making their own model Parthenon.

Art: children will study Ancient Greek art and create their own art works in that style.

Music: learn about musical notation

Mathematics

Number System, measures, statistics and algebra

This half term children will be learning:

- Order and compare numbers using place value;
- Use the units on the metric system to measure and to convert between units;
- Interpret and represent data using a range of graphs;
- Use symbols to represent unknown numbers;
- Solve equations with unknown numbers.

Science

In Science we will be learning about Evolution and inheritance during which unit children will learn to recognise that living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago.

Computing

- Children will use data programmes to represent and analyse data they will have collected in maths lessons.
