Literacy

Our topics in the Early Years Unit next term will be Dinosaurs. We will be focusing on literature around dinosaurs. We will be using both fiction and non-fiction books to learn how to obtain information from written text. We will be learning to enjoy a large range of books and using these books to support our phonic learning. In EYFS we will be extending our phonic knowledge within our classes to support our writing.

Mathematics

During this term in maths we will be exploring the different concepts of time, space and measure.

We will look at how big dinosaurs are and compare size and understanding of size in our maths learning.

This term we will also be building on our number skills by understanding quantity by working on one more and one less, sharing into objects, groups and solving basic number problems.

RE

This term in RE we will be starting off by looking at different religions. We will start with Judaism and talk about the different celebrations.

Later in the term we will be looking at The Holy Family, Jesus's life and when Jesus was a little boy.

Understanding of the world

Our topic this term will help us expand our knowledge in the world around us as we will be looking at the similarities and differences in our world now and then.

We will be talking about what the dinosaurs would eat. We will be looking at the different kinds of dinosaurs and the different landscapes that they lived in.

EAD

While exploring dinosaurs we will be experimenting with the different textures and colours. Our topic will also help us be imaginative in our role-play.

Communication and Language

We will be using different areas within our curriculum to build our language skills. We will be focusing on asking and forming questions related to dinosaurs. We will be using talk to organise our ideas and explain what is happening.

PSED

Within PSED we will be building on confidence skills and communication language skills to help the children talk about their likes and dislikes.

We will be building on how children express their feelings and can talk about how they feel.

Whole school events, assemblies, masses and trips

This term we will start using our new area under the canopy! We will have expanded the areas available for the children to explore and learn in.

Our school trip this term will be to the Natural History Museum to see the dinosaurs! Our proposed date for the trip is the 1st February 2017.



PD

With the completion of our outdoor area within our EYFS unit, we will be using this space to ride bikes, climb and play different games.

We are building on PD skills to help strengthen pencil grips and pencil hold. We will be completing cutting exercises to help fine motor skills.
