Provision	Cost	Impact on pupils
Specialist coaching - Dance (Y3)	£1696.25	Dance has been targeted at Year 3 pupils who would benefit from increased activity, confidence and performance skills.
Gymnastics (Y2 & Y4)	£2800	Gymnastics has improved pupils' core skills, agility, balance and coordination.
Netball (Y3 - Y6)	£1020	Netball coaching supported pupils to acquire new skills and experience a new sport. The Y5/6 netball team benefited from the coaching and were able to develop their skills to a high level which enabled them to win the CSSA league and go on to the London Youth Games.
Cricket (Y4 – Y6)	£850	Cricket coaching supported pupils to acquire new skills, understand the game and rules of cricket and compete in Camden schools competitions. Cricket provision was targeted at pupils who would benefit from improved team work, concentration, focus to support them to manage their own behaviour and understand the importance of following rules.
Tag Rugby (Y4 – Y6)	£135	Tag rugby coaching introduced pupils to the game of rugby and enabled a team to gain the necessary skills to enter the Camden Schools Tag Rugby competition.
Camden School Sports Association (CSSA) – Access to school sports competitions	Membership - £450 Staffing – clubs and competitions £1620	Pupils of all abilities are able to participate in competitive sporting competition. More able pupils have been successful in Netball, Football and Basketball competitions and have gone on to represent the Borough in the London Youth Games. Less able pupils take part in inclusive competitions which enables them to experience competitive sport at an appropriate level and develop an interest in sport and playing within a team.
Staff training – Level 5 Sports Leader Award	£2040	This is a recognised qualification that aims to upskill primary school teachers and higher level teaching assistants to improve the overall delivery of the physical education curriculum within primary schools. On successful completion of this qualification, delegates will be able to assist in raising the standards within primary school physical education teaching and learning.
Staff training – Fit Families	£460	Two members of staff are undertaking 'Fit Families' training in order to deliver the programme to pupils and their families. The aim of the programme is to encourage healthy eating, increased activity and to provide opportunities for families to enjoy undertaking healthy and active activities together.
Resources – New playground equipment	£1119.19	New playground equipment was purchased in order to provide more activities for the pupils during breaks and to encourage activity and provide sufficient resources for all children to have access to equipment.
Gym mats	£403.05	Additional mats purchased to increase the number of pupils who are able to attend the Gymnastic Clubs.
