What is Phase One Phonics?

Early phonics teaching in Nursery that focuses on developing children's listening skills. This phase is intended to develop children's listening, vocabulary and speaking skills.

Children are taught about:

- Environmental sounds
- Instrumental sounds
- Body percussion (e.g. clapping and stamping)
- Rhythm and rhyme
- Alliteration
- Oral blending and segmenting
- Voice sounds

- Listening walks
- Playing and identifying instruments
- Action songs
- Rhymes
- I spy
- I say, you say (rhyming game)
- Shared reading
