Notice of intention to discontinue St Aloysius Catholic primary school

The governing body has been consulting on the possibility of closing the school on or after 31 December 2019. A decision was taken by the governing body on 6 June 2019 to take forward the process by publishing this statutory notice, with the agreement of the RC Diocese of Westminster.

The reason for the proposal to discontinue the school is:

- a fall in the number of children joining the school, leading to over 40% of the school's places being unfilled in 2018/19;
- fewer school age children in the local area, reflected in Camden's 'live births' data 2005/6 to 2016/17
- 421 actual primary school places from reception to Yr6 were unfilled within the local Planning Area in 2018/19
